

**Northeast Neighbors (NeN) Board Meeting Minutes**  
**December 13, 2021, 6:30 p.m.**

**Call to Order:** 6:32 p.m.

**Food Drive:** Multi-NHA food drive scheduled for February 13. Anne will find location for our local collection. In early January, eNews will begin recruiting volunteers. The postcard announcing the General Meeting will also promote the drive. Kevin will be asked to source a dolly.

**January 20 General Meeting:**

- Jim has sent acting Superintendent Vandercar initial questions. Mailings will ask for further questions. Board members should also suggest questions.
- Second topic: further development potential in the NeN area, looking at 10-20 year horizon. Gabe Flock in Eugene Planning is coordinating staff and will find speakers. They will assess potential for development both within current UGB and also if adjacent Urban Reserve is opened up. They will discuss potential impact of current land-use code revisions based on HB 2001.

**HB 2001 code changes:** Planning Commission recommendations go to City Council in January. Public Hearing in March.

**NeN's OCCU account:** When we pay web hosting fees (\$155) in January, \$531 will be left in the account. The Sheppard Motors sponsorship of the newsletter ends January 31. We need to find a new sponsor.

**Striker Field update:** Completion expected fall of 2022. New name is in "intergovernmental negotiations."

**Gilham Road Upgrade:** Lane's Transportation Advisory Committee on 11/17 recommended using existing funds for phase one (fill in sidewalks on both sides Ayres to Don Juan) and seeking new funds for phase two (continue sidewalk on west side through Sterling Park Place). Construction planned for spring 2023.
