

NeN Board Minutes for 3/25/24

Began meeting: 6:35 pm

Board Attendees: John Faville, Rick Edwards, Anne Millhollen, Brian Martsfield, Kirstin London
Approve minutes 2/5/24 Board Meeting. Anne moved; Rick seconded; approved unanimously.

Planning the April 16th mayoral forum

- Key procedures: questions sent to candidates the day before; no questions from floor/online; 3 min intros, 45 min of Q&A with 90 second answers, 2 min conclusions; John opens the meeting; Katie Werner, Cal Young Chair, moderates the forum.
- NeN roles: set-up, entry table, host laptop (Kirstin, with back-up), AV (Jesse)
- Cal Young roles: moderate the forum, timekeeper, help with set-up
- KLCC table for questions about elections
- Creating the question list:
 - E-news 3/27 soliciting questions, requiring submissions by 4/8. Remind e-news 4/5.
 - Need Board suggestions by 4/8.
 - All questions in shared Google doc. Agree as board by 4/11.
 - Coordinate/finalize list with Cal Young. Send to the candidates 4/15.

Follow up on safe streets from March 5th meeting.

- Priorities for talking to City Transportation Planning as follow up: 1. Gilham Road speeding & crosswalks, extra need during holidays; 2. Trucks and others speeding, rolling stops, rapid acceleration on N Delta (speed study) and Coburg; 3. Crescent Ave enhanced crossing at Grand Cayman, speed study for automated sign; 4. School zones near Cal Young, especially Benson Lane (also speak with Safe Routes to School director)
- Question: Is a roundabout planned for N Delta/Ayres?
- Invite EPD representation to board or general meeting: more patrolling? citizen actions?

Follow up on preparedness from March 5th meeting. No action planned.
