

LANE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

IN THE MATTER OF LEGALIZING A PORTION OF GILHAM ROAD, LOCATED IN SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN (17-03-08).

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners for Lane County, Oregon through the adoption of Order Numbers 20-08-18-14 and 20-09-15-06, has deemed that it may be of public benefit to legalize a portion of the road, commonly known as Gilham Road; and

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes 368.201 provides for legalization of County Roads where certain conditions exist which include, as in this case, a County Road that through omission or defect, doubt exists as to the legal establishment or evidence of establishment as a County Road, and the said Board being satisfied that the legalization of the road, which is part of the traveled and maintained County Road System, will be of public utility and benefit; and will enable a survey of the road by these proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Board may deem it necessary and expedient and in the best interest of the public for Gilham Road to be legalized as a County Road, with a right of way width determined as previously established through numerous public road dedications by deed and the subdivision process; and

WHEREAS, legal notice is being provided by service and posting in accordance with ORS 368.206 (c) and ORS 368.401 to 368.426; and

WHEREAS, on **October 20, 2020 at 1:30 P.M.**, the **Lane County Board of Commissioners will conduct a Public Hearing via webinar** to formally consider the legalization of a portion of Gilham Road. 1. The Final Order to legalize a portion of Gilham Road be approved as proposed.
2. Continue the matter for further consideration.
3. Deny the Final Order to legalize and discontinue proceedings.
